

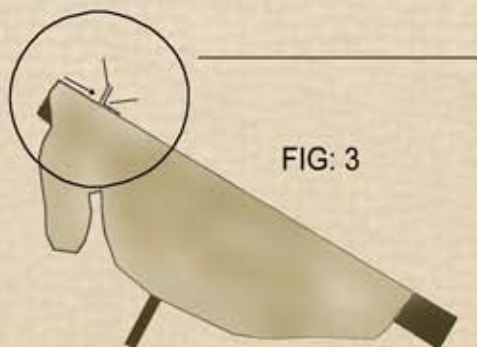

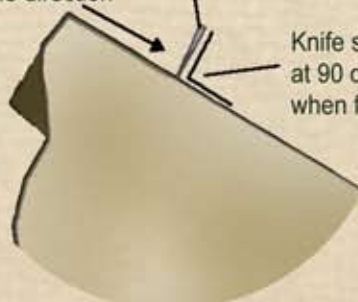

Flesh in one direction

Knife Blade

Knife should be kept
at 90 degrees to the skin
when fleshing



All chemicals are best used warmed up. In the case of chemicals stored in polythene containers this can be done by immersing the container in another container of boiling water. REMOVE LID from the sealed container first.

May be harmful by inhalation, ingestion or through skin absorption. Severe eye irritant - eye contact may cause serious damage. In case of contact with eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice. Wear gloves, apron & eye / face protection.

Run off from rinsing should be disposed of into the foul waste system and not allowed to enter any natural water course.
